## Year 2 Visit to Lulworth Cove – Thursday 20th June 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited to be taking all of our Year 2 children to Lulworth Cove. During Geography, we have been exploring our local coastline thinking about what human and physical features there are as well as exploring local habitats. To continue our learning, we are going to be looking at the habitats around the cove and the children will also have the opportunity to do some rock pooling to investigate what sea creatures live around the cove. We will also be looking at local tourism and what attracts visitors to the cove. In the afternoon, children will have some down time to look at the local landscape or objects they find on the beach to practice their art skills and produce some lovely sketches

Children will need:

- weather appropriate clothes (non-school uniform)
- water bottle filled with water
- suncream and a sun hat
- sturdy walking boots/ shoes,
- wellie boots in a named plastic bag (we will use them and then leave on the coach).
- A rucksack (**essential**) as we will be carrying our own packed lunches.

Fruit snacks will be provided by the school.

**Timings:** We will be travelling to Lulworth Cove by coach. We will be leaving school at 9.00am and arriving back to school by 3.00pm (approximate timings). This will not affect your drop off and pickup times due to the departure/arrival times being within school hours. Children should arrive at normal time for registration.

**Cost:** To cover the cost of the trip we request a voluntary contribution of **£9.50 per child**, made via your child's Wisepay account. If you wish, you could pay in two instalments of £4.75. **We will need to collect sufficient contributions in order for the visit to go ahead.** Please come and speak to your child's class teacher if you have any concerns.

**Lunch:** Children in KS1 are entitled to free school meals so if required we can provide a packed lunch for the visit. If you would like the kitchen to provide a packed lunch please indicate on the form attached. Please note the kitchen can only cater for medical requests that they have previously been notified about for the school lunch box, no other requests will be considered. **If you do not indicate on the form that you want a school packed lunch, then you will need to provide one from home.**

**Permission** Please could you return the attached permission slip and make your contribution via Wisepay no later than **Friday 14th June 2024.**

We are very much looking forward to our visit and the exciting activities that we will be doing.
