We can now confirm the new app for WisePay has been set up for our school and is ready to go!!

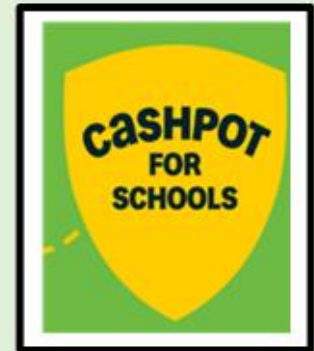
- The app can be found in both the Apple Store & Google Play.

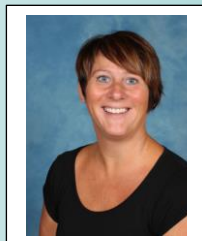
Hot School Lunches are now available to book via your child's Wisepay account.

Deadline for ordering hot lunches is Tuesday 21st January for week commencing Monday 27th January 2025.

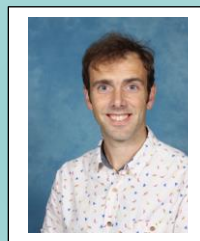

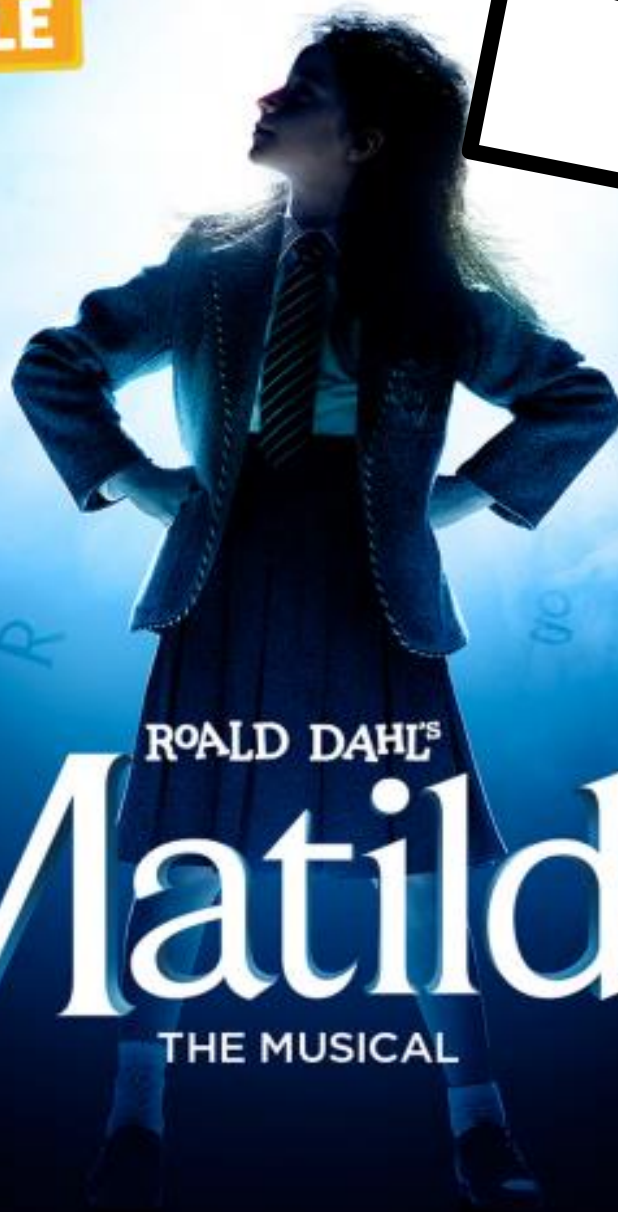
