Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that all your child will be taught swimming and water safety at Stoborough School on these dates: 1/7/24, 8/7/24 (Monday morning) and 18/7/24 (Thursday morning).

As part of the National Curriculum, the expectation is that by the end of KS2 all children should be able to swim unaided for a distance of at least 25 metres, using recognised strokes, on their front and back and demonstrate an understanding of how to rescue themselves in a water-based situation, we are therefore legally obliged to deliver this as part of our national curriculum.

On the day, your child will need to bring their swimming kit in a bag. They must have a swimming costume/ trunks, a towel, a small bottle of water and a book to read. (Swimming goggles are optional). Two-part bikinis or Bermuda shorts are not appropriate school swimwear.

A trained lifeguard will be there to support the children as well as our trained swimming teacher, Mrs Allen.

We will be hiring a minibus to transport the children there and back, so we do request a voluntary contribution of £12.00 (£4 per session which is cheaper than outside swimming lessons).

Please can you return the slip below with confirmation of your child's confidence and competency in water so that we can make our plans accordingly.
