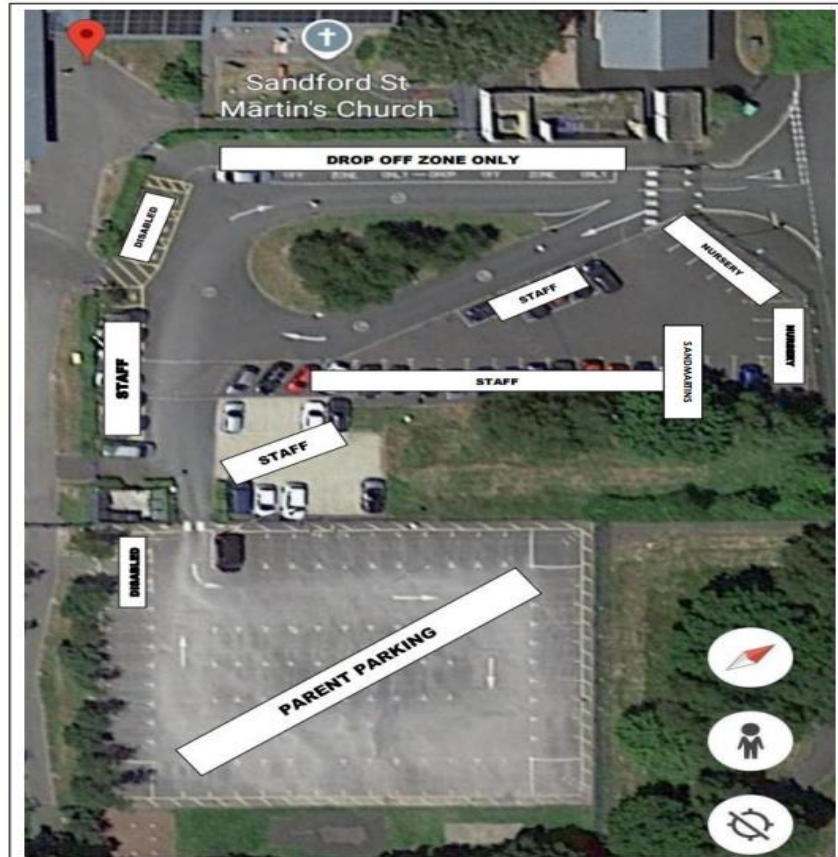


CAR PARK

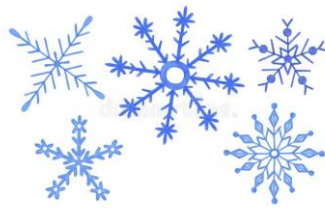
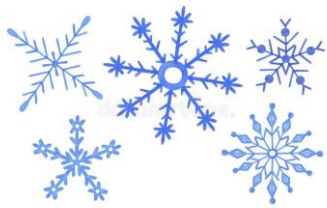
