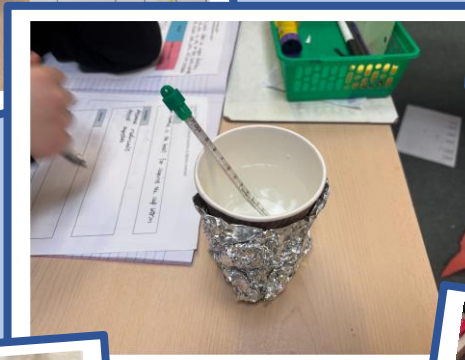
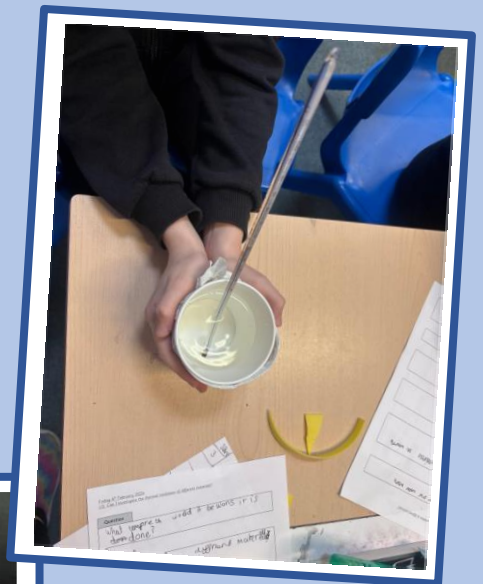
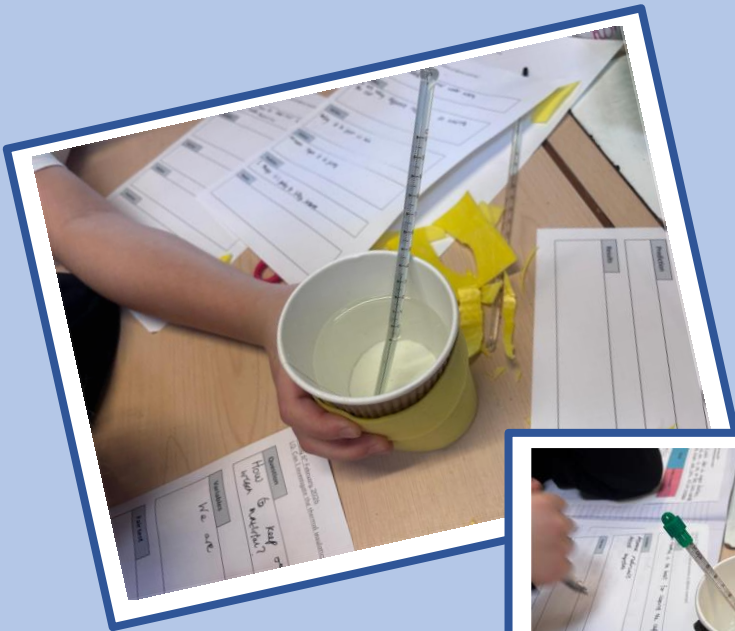
# Y3 NEWS

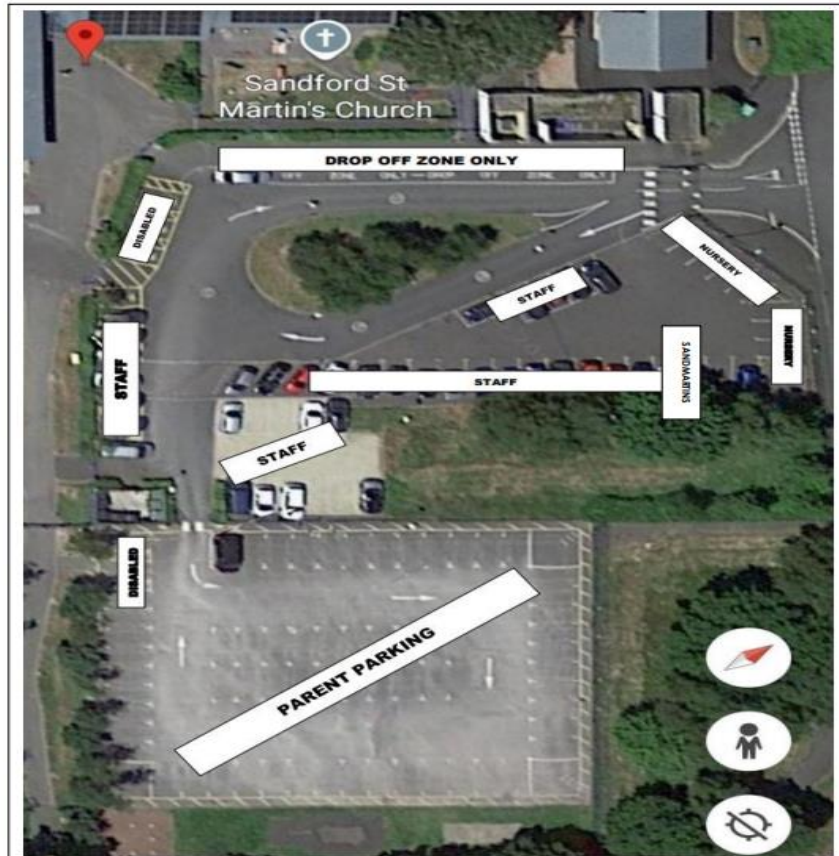


# CAR PARK

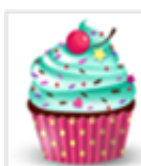

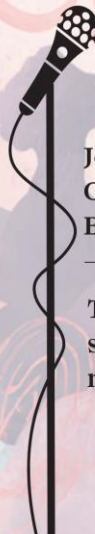
