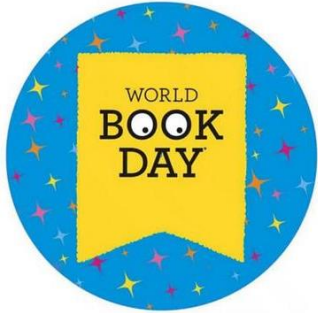

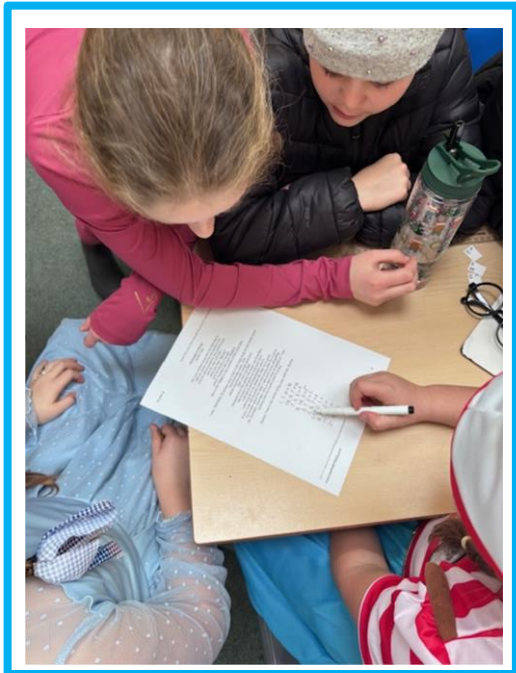
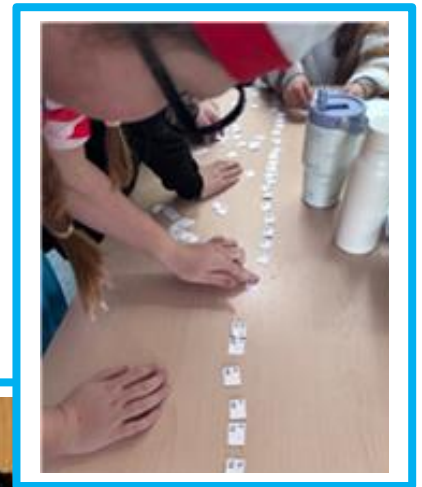

The children then got to taste a range of fruit and vegetables- lots of children trying things they haven't tasted before!



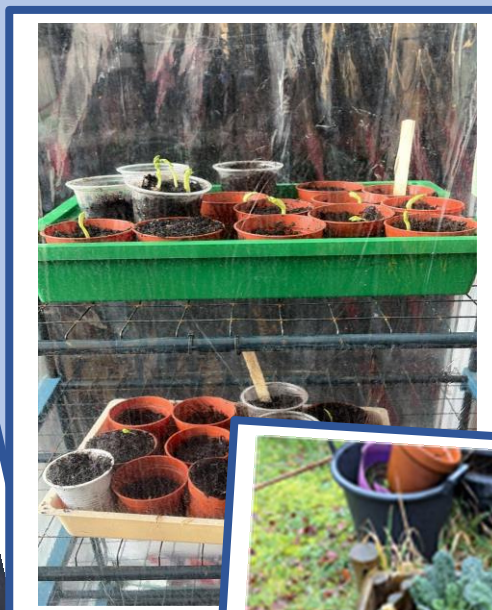
# GARDENING CLUB

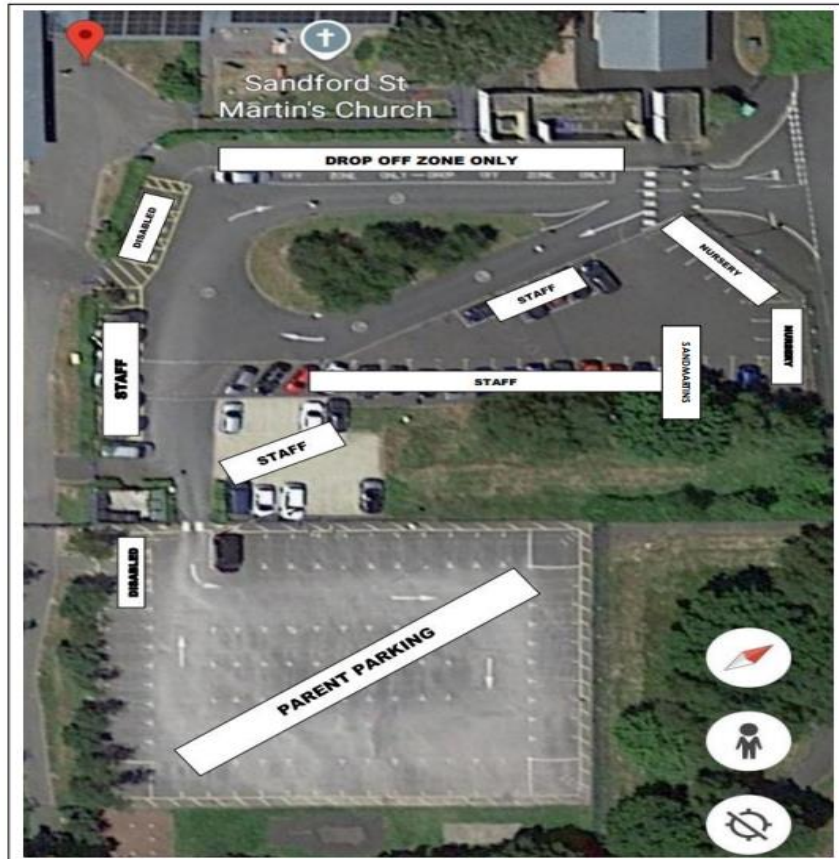


# CAR PARK

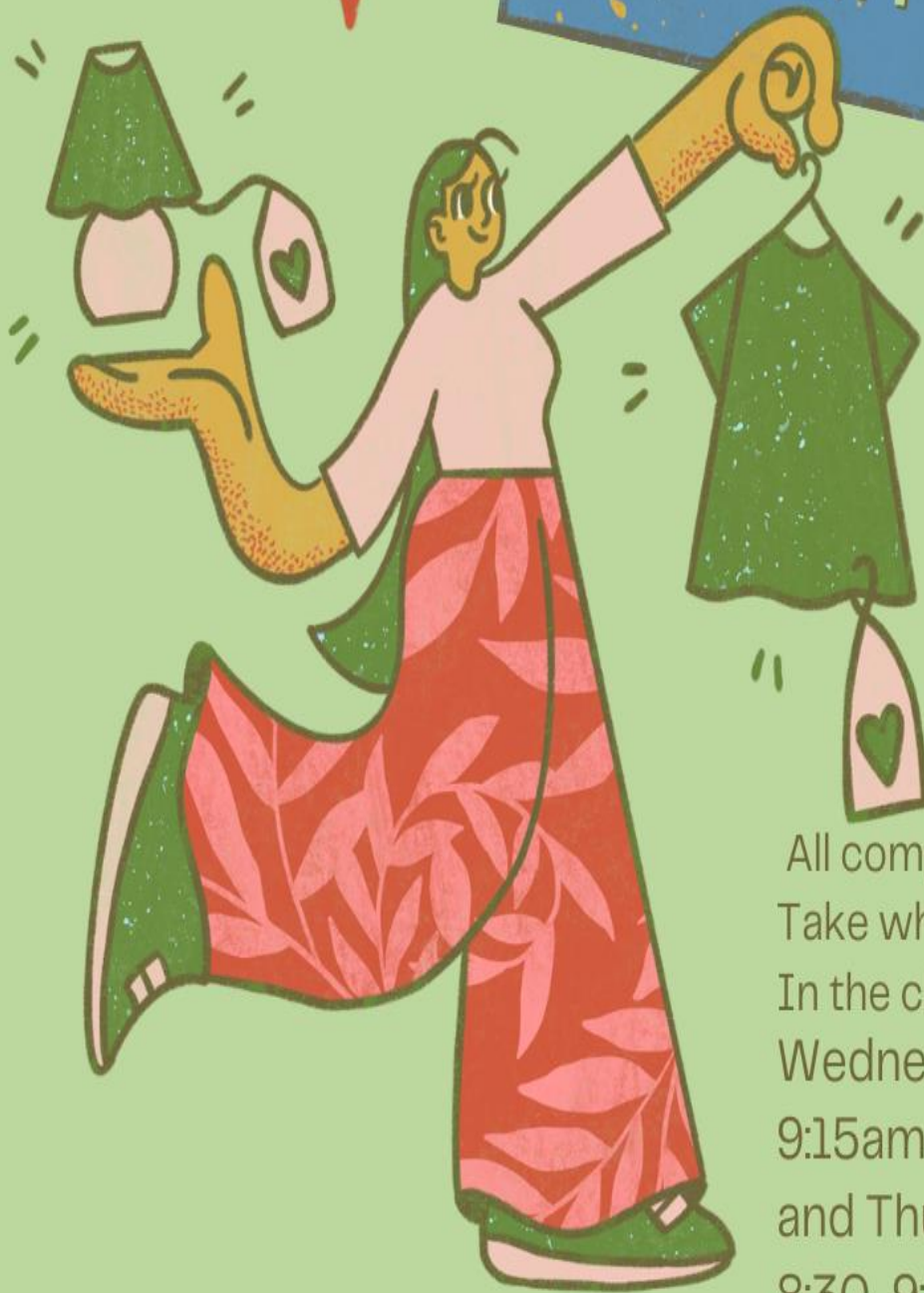
