We are now a month into our new school year. It started a little later this year due to elections in Uganda. Our new baby class has started (ages 3-4) and are settling in to life at school.



Thank you so much to all the schools who have sent us donations, either through doing last year's GAL day or by doing your own fundraising. We are so grateful for all your support and it makes such a huge difference to our children. This year we are using the money raised for a variety of things to enhance learning for our children. The main project is our nursery outdoor area. Previously they did not have their own area so we did not have suitable equipment for them. So far we have purchased swings and a slide and we hope to increase the equipment when we receive more donations. The children absolutely love their new equipment.



We are also using the money raised to support subjects in primary- art materials for art/craft lessons; seeds for the agriculture plot; resources for practical lessons eg cooking and science; sports equipment and entering competitions in athletics, ball games, music and spelling.

We have just had a couple from the UK come and volunteer with us for 3 weeks. They helped us with our nursery outdoor area by building a sandpit and doing a mural of Elmer the elephant. This was the first time our children have played in a sandpit and they are really enjoying it.



We have had a few video calls between Child of Hope and schools in the UK. All the children absolutely love talking to each other and sharing life in the different countries. Please let me know if you'd like to arrange a call.
