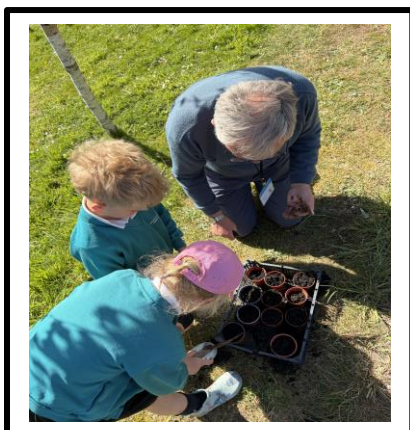
Our new headteacher, Mrs Roberts, will be there so come and say hello.

## Sandford St Martin's Reach the Purbeck Cup Final!

Sandford St Martin's have successfully made it through to the final of the Purbeck Cup after an exciting 3–1 victory over St Mary's School in Swanage.

On a very hot afternoon, the team did themselves and the school proud with an impressive performance full of determination, resilience and teamwork. The match got off to a difficult start, with St Mary's scoring within the opening three minutes. However, Sandford showed great character, refusing to let their heads drop. They responded brilliantly, creating a number of chances but just couldn't find the breakthrough before half time.

In the second half, Tyler fired Sandford back into the game with a well-taken equaliser, setting up a tense and closely fought contest. Jasper was a calm and reliable presence in goal, supported by some outstanding defending from Mayank, Carter and Cody. Sandford continued to press, with Arlo, Chase, Emerson, George and Tyler all coming close to scoring. With the score locked at 1–1 at full time, the game moved into extra time. It was Emerson who broke the deadlock with a fantastic strike into the corner, before Tyler sealed the victory with a composed finish.

A brilliant team performance sees Sandford through to the final—an incredible achievement.

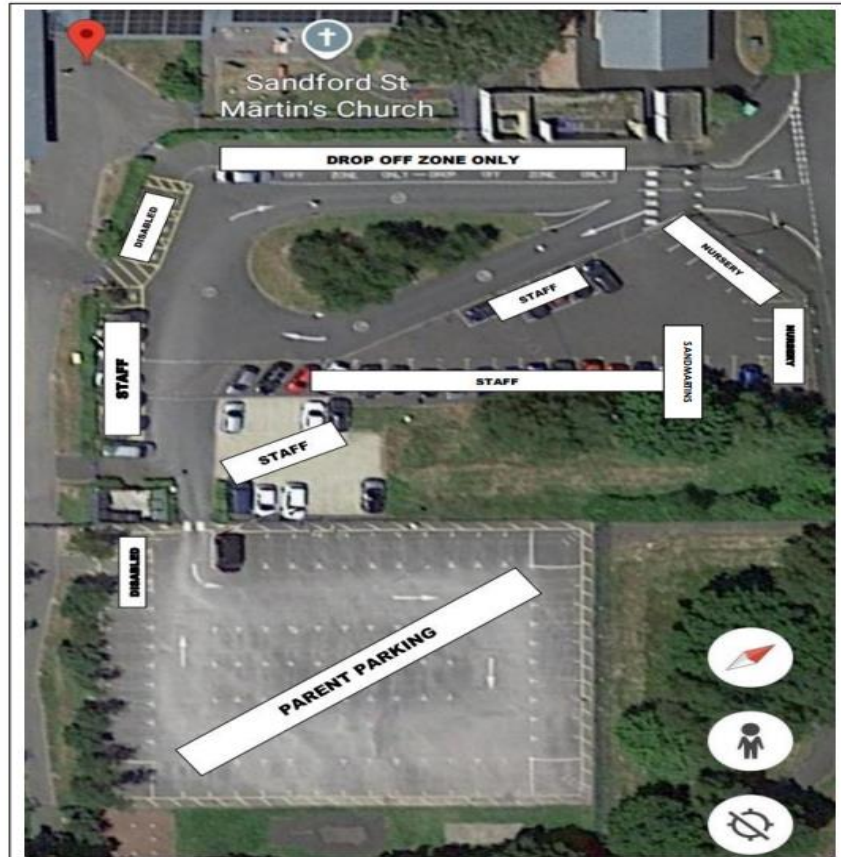

# CAR PARK

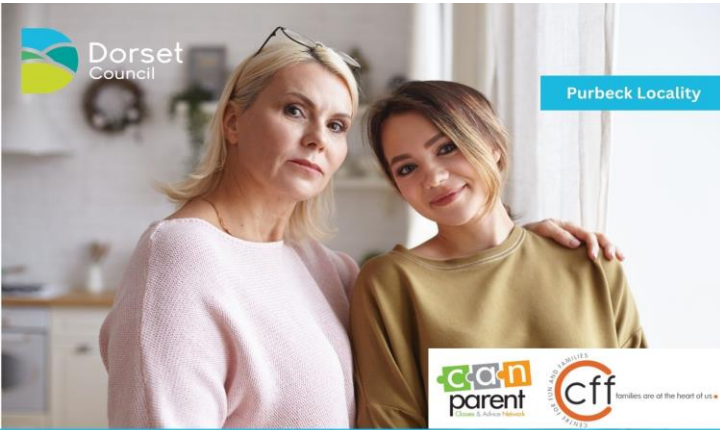

Chapman's Pool - One of those magical places that makes you feel like you've stepped into a storybook. A day filled with surprises! Sweeping coastal views from the cliff top, clambering down a rope to reach the hidden cove (there is an alternative path avoiding the rope), fossil hunting on the beach and even a driftwood swing perfect for a family photo. When the spring sunshine arrives and the ground finally starts to dry, it's the ideal time to visit. Start your journey from Worth Matravers car park then head over fields from Weston.

**A few things to keep in mind:**  
 This is a proper outdoorsy adventure - no toilets, no café, no bins, and likely very little phone signal. Pack snacks, bring water, and leave nothing but footprints behind.
