PRIMARY SCHOOL

Dear Parents and Carers,

The governors and I would like to thank all those of you who responded to our recent survey. We had 74 replies.

The main findings were all very positive:

- 93% were either satisfied or very satisfied with the school and 92% of you would recommend us to another family.
- 88% of you said that their child enjoys coming to school and 90% felt that our teaching was of a high standard.
- A large majority (83%) thought that we promote good behaviour and 88% felt that their child's wellbeing was being supported.
- 82% thought that we kept them well-informed about their child and 94% felt comfortable approaching staff with concerns.
- 88% felt listened to and 89% agreed that we have high expectations.
- 97% praised our positive ethos and values and 82% said we keep them well-informed about school life.
- 97% are either satisfied or very satisfied with our facilities and 84% agreed or strongly agreed that we provide a good range of trips.

In the free text section there was praise for our sense of community, our safe, welcoming and supportive environment, the quality of teaching and our enrichment activities.

When asked what we could to improve, there was mention of streamlining our communications home and giving earlier notice of future events; greater consistency in our response to poor behavior; looking again at home learning; problems with the car park; and providing more information about what children are learning in class.

We will be looking to address all those comments over the coming weeks. Some of you referred to an individual concern about your child. Please do contact me at school if you would like to discuss this. We shall be running the survey again in the new school year.

Our doors are opening once again on Wednesdays straight after school drop off in the church space.

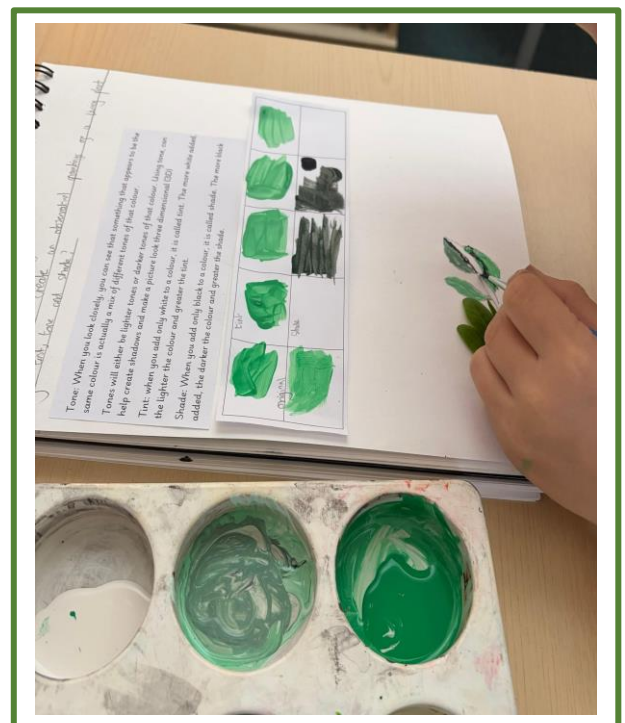
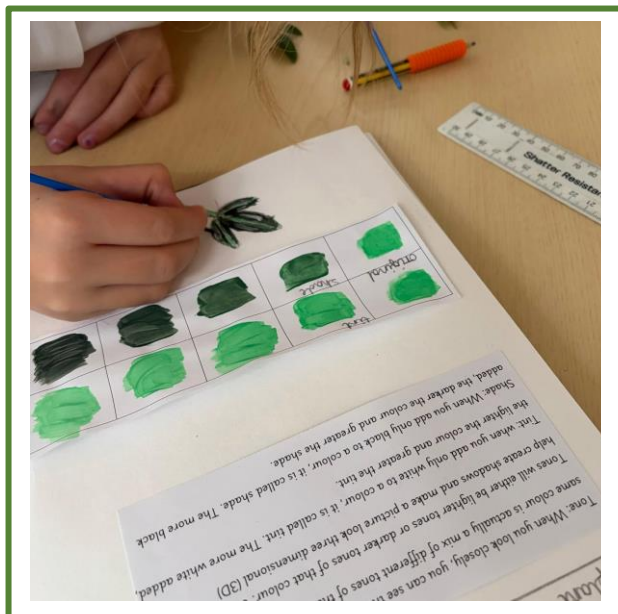

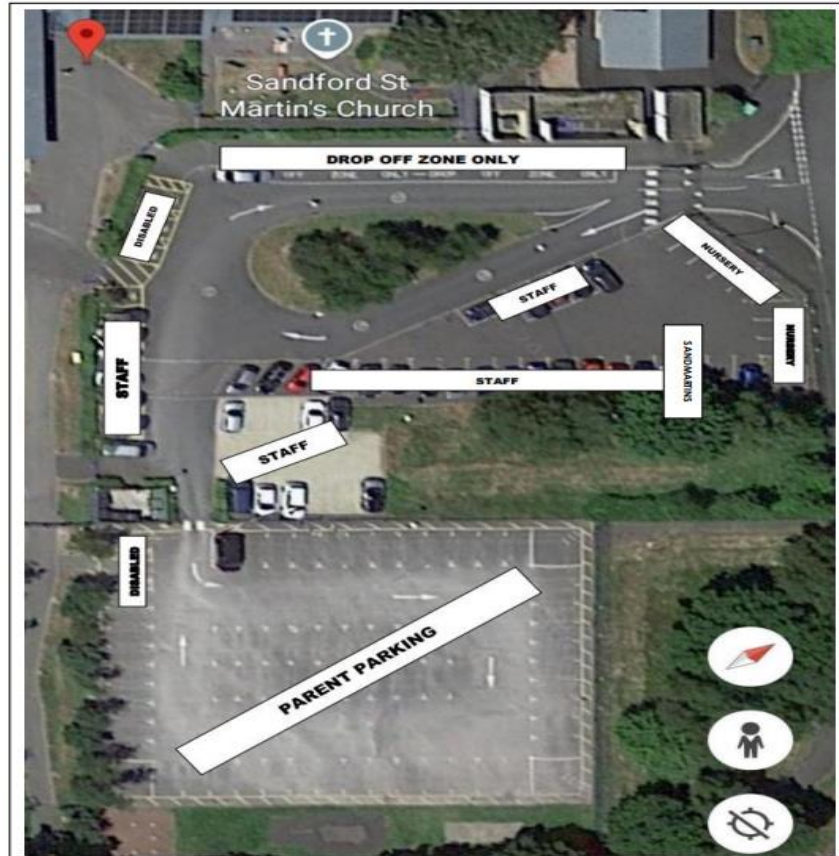


CAR PARK
