Changes to School Uniform Year 4 only

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare to introduce mixed-age Year 3 and Year 4 classes, we would like to inform you of a small update to our uniform expectations for Year 4 pupils. From this change, **Year 4 children will wear a white polo shirt throughout the school year**, in line with Year 3. This adjustment has been made to support a consistent approach across the lower Key Stage 2 and to reflect the new class structure.

Please note that this change applies only to Year 4. Pupils in Years 5 and 6 will continue to wear shirts and ties as part of their uniform. The rest of the school uniform remains unchanged, and all other expectations for appearance and presentation will continue to apply as normal.

We believe this is a practical change that will help create consistency for pupils and families while keeping the uniform appropriate for each stage of the school, including awareness of costs. We are confident that this updated arrangement will be straightforward for parents and carers and will help pupils feel settled as they move into their new mixed-age classes.
