Year 3 Winchester Science Museum Trip – Wednesday 5th June 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 5th June, Year 3 will be going to Winchester Science Centre. It will be a great trip to bring together all of our Science and Computing learning from throughout Year 3. We will give the children time to explore the Science centre, as well as have a workshop led by a member of the team and a show at the Planetarium.

Children are allowed to wear their own clothes, but should wear a school jumper or cardigan over the top to make them easily visible. It is going to be a very active day so please wear suitable clothing and suitable shoes such as trainers.

<u>Timings</u>: We will be travelling by coach to Winchester Science Museum. To be able to get the most out of the day, we will be leaving school at **8:45am**. Children will need to arrive at school promptly for **8:30am**. We will spend the whole day at the Science Centre, and will return to school at 3.30pm (approximate timings).

<u>Cost:</u> To cover the cost of the trip we require a voluntary contribution of £14.40 per child, made via your child's Wisepay account. If you wish, you could pay in two instalments of $\pounds7.20$. We will need to collect sufficient contributions in order for the visit to go ahead. Please come and speak to your child's class teacher if you have any concerns.

Lunch: Children will require a packed lunch, water bottle and healthy snack for the trip in a named bag or lunch box. If your child is entitled to free school meals and would like the kitchen to provide a packed lunch, please indicate this on the form attached. Please note the kitchen can only cater for medical requests that they have previously been notified about for the school lunch box, no other requests will be considered.

Parental help: We need additional adult support on the day so if you would like to join us please complete the section on the form attached. We will inform you nearer the date should we need your help. In the event that we have lots of volunteers we will draw names from a hat.

<u>Permission</u> Please could you return the attached permission slip and make your contribution via Wisepay no later than **Monday 20th May 2024**. We cannot take your child out of school without this.
