Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that all of Year 3 will be taught swimming and water safety at Purbeck School every Monday morning starting on 22/04/2023. The children will have 4 sessions and their last session will be on the 20/05/2022.

As part of the National Curriculum, the expectation is that by the end of KS2 all children should be able to swim unaided for a distance of at least 25 metres, using recognised strokes, on their front and back and demonstrate an understanding of how to rescue themselves in a water based situation, we are therefore legally obliged to deliver this as part of our national curriculum. We are aware that some children may already be able to swim 25m (the required distance for primary aged children), so the classes will be grouped accordingly by our qualified instructors so that all children are challenged whatever their current ability. A trained lifeguard will be there to support the children as well as 2 trained swimming teachers, all of whom are our own school staff.

On the day, your child will need to bring their swimming kit in a bag. They must have a swimming costume/ trunks, a towel, a small bottle of water and a book to read. (Swimming goggles are optional). Two part bikinis or bermuda shorts are not appropriate school swimwear.

We will be hiring a coach to transport the children there and back, so we do request a voluntary contribution of $\pounds 16.80$ ($\pounds 4.20$ per session) for the 4 weeks. This is considerably cheaper than paying for swimming lessons privately and can be paid via wise pay.

Please can you return the slip below, with confirmation of your child's confidence and competency in water, so that we can make our plans accordingly.
