NB: No jewellery - necklaces, bracelets etc to be worn in school. Small stud earrings are permitted. Watches can be worn, these should not have messaging, phoning, gaming or photography functions. Long hair must be tied up. Extreme styles and hair colouring are not permitted.

#### Second-hand Uniform

The PTA and Governors have a stock of pre-loved uniform within school. This is available for parents/carers at a preloved sale which is held at the beginning of every half term, for three days before & after school, at the new parents evening and at the School Fair in July. If needed at other times during the year it can be accessed by asking or emailing the School Office. In all cases a small donation is suggested but not required.

#### Dr Bike check-up

As your local Sustrans Bike It Officers, we have organised Dr Bike maintenance days on **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> April.** This is to ensure that those cycling to school are doing so on bikes which are safe and fit for purpose.

We will be at the school during the school day, completing basic cycle maintenance and safety checks on all bikes whose owners have given us permission to have them checked over. We should have time to complete most simple repairs, depending on the number of bikes and timings on the day.
