

Sport Premium (SPM) Statement Sept 2016 - Aug 2017

In April 2013, the Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport announced new funding of £150 million to support the delivery of PE and school sport.

Our allocation for the period 1st September 2016 to 31st August 2017 is £9510.

Currently, we are using this funding to support the engagement of children and the development of our PE and sports provision in the following ways:

- Implementation of new (Change for Life) C4L club
- Implementation of C4L Week
- Purchase of further equipment to support our expanding sporting provision
- Insurance and petrol costs to enable colleagues to transport children to and from fixtures
- Release time to support Head of P.E. to organise, arrange and oversee our involvement in a range of sporting fixtures and initiatives
- Over-time payment to TAs running after school clubs or helping with transport
- Running of and preparation for Sports Day
- Payment of extra adult when needed to take children to fixtures
- Annual subscription to Purbeck and East Dorset School Sports Association (PEDSSA)
- Provision of catch-up swimming lessons

Ways we have planned to use the funding for the remainder of the year:

- Development of active playtimes and outdoor environment.
