

# Pirates - Year 1



## Essential Knowledge

By the end of this topic the children will know....

- Use a range of art and design techniques to create a pirate themed island
- Children will learn about pirates from the past and the local area
- Children will be able to retell a significant event from the past
- Children will know how to share information on a topic (pirate fact file)

### Launch

#### Pirates assemble sharing our learning

Children will watch a pirate themed film e.g. The Pirates – Band of Misfits, Peter Pan or Hook.

### Explore

#### Real life pirates

Children will learn about real life pirates from the past, including Harry Paye who is local to the area. (Lessons will be uploaded to your Class Dojo each week)

### Energise

#### A day in the life of a pirate

The children will wear their own pirate hat creation and reconstruct a 'piratey' event e.g. make a family member walk the plank or find the buried treasure.

#### Pirate treasure hunt!
